SATURDAY/SUNDAY STABLEFORD

COMPETITIONS

1. Only 7 day members will be allowed to play in Saturday / Sunday stablefords.
2. All returned cards should include:
 - a) The players name
 - b) The players handicap
 - c) The date of competition
 - d) The competition name
 - e) Both the gross score and stableford points for each hole and the total stableford points.

Failure to comply with the above may lead to a suspension of handicap or a suspension of a players right to play in club competitions.

3. Stableford competition results will be posted on the notice board for the following sections:

| Section 1 | - | Scratch to 12 |
| Section 2 | - | 13 to 18 |
| Section 3 | - | 19 to 28. |
4. Handicap strokes are to be taken at the holes allocated by the course stroke index.
5. The winner and any joint winners of each section will qualify for the stableford final (Sherwood Trophy), which will be played on a date shown on the fixture card.
6. All full seven day members will be allowed to play a stableford round on the day of the stableford final and although only those who qualified will count for the final, the winners of each section of the stableford on the day will qualify for the following seasons final in accordance with normal competition rules.
7. The stableford point are to be allocated in the following manner:

|-------------------------------|---|----------|
| Net double bogey (2 over par) | - | 0 points |
| Net bogey (1 over par) | - | 1 point |
| Net par | - | 2 points |
| Net birdie (1 under par) | - | 3 points |
| Net eagle (2 under par) | - | 4 points |
| Net albatross (3 under par) | - | 5 points |
8. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the usual count back system.
