PAUL TROPHY (Gents Par Competition)

COMPETITION RULES (In Addition To The General Rules)

1. Members wishing to play in the Paul Trophy must play in either of the two qualifying rounds which are shown on the fixture card. A player may only play in one qualifying round, if a player submits two cards his second will be discarded.
2. The player shall record his gross score at each hole as in normal medal play. However for this competition only the player is required to record his status after each hole as indicated:-

A net birdie or better will be shown as	+
A net par will be shown as	0
A net bogey or worse will be shown as	-

The final score against the course will be recorded as a + figure, even or a – figure.

3. The competition will be played on full handicap allowance, handicap strokes are to be taken at the holes indicated by the stroke index.
4. The top 32 scores and those tying on 32nd place will go forward to play in the Paul Trophy final (scores achieved in qualifying will be carried over to the final). The winner will be the player with the best score at the end of the final round (the aggregate of the qualifying round and the final round).
5. In the event of a tie in the final the winner will be decided on a count back system (scoring being against the course):-

Better second round
Better inward nine holes second round
Better last six holes second round
Better last three holes second round
If still equal a single hole count back from the 18th will be used to determine the winner.
