HOPKINS TROPHY **(Stableford Aged 55 Years & over)**

COMPETITION RULES (In Addition To The General Rules)

1. The Hopkins Trophy is a competition for both Gents and Lady members aged 55 years (young) and over. The competition will take the form of a stableford competition, to be played over two rounds on the dates as shown on the fixture card.
2. The winner is the player with the highest aggregate stableford score.
3. The competition will be played on full handicap allowance.
4. Normal stableford rules will apply.
5. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided on a count back system (based on stableford points):-

Better inward nine holes

Better last six holes

Better last three holes

If still equal a single hole count back from the 18th will be used to determine the winner.

5. Since the Hopkins Trophy is generally played as part of a normal stableford competition all eligible members are requested to clearly identify HOPKINS TROPHY on their score cards as well as the normal medal information, otherwise their card may be disregarded. The M&H cannot accept responsibility for cards not clearly identified and it is unlikely that disregarded scores would be re-entered!
