MORRISON TROPHY (Husband & Wife)

COMPETITION RULES (In Addition To The General Rules)

1. The Morrison Trophy is open to all husband & wife partnerships who are both full 7 day playing members of the club. All partnerships wishing to play in the Morrison Trophy must include their names on the entry sheet posted on the notice board. The competition will take the form of a stableford foursomes competition, to be played over two rounds on the dates as shown on the fixture card.
2. The winners will be the partnership with the highest aggregate stableford score over the two rounds.
3. The maximum handicap allowance for this competition shall be 28 for men and 36 for ladies. Each sides handicap will be half of their combined playing handicaps (0.1 to 0.4 will be rounded down, 0.5 and up will be rounded up).
4. Handicap strokes are to be given at the holes indicated on the Gents stroke index.
5. Gents will play from the white tee markers and Ladies will play from the red tee markers.
6. Normal stableford rules will apply.
7. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided on a count back system (based on stableford points):-

Better stableford score second round

Better stableford score for inward nine holes second round

Better stableford score for last six holes second round

Better stableford score for last three holes second round

If still equal a single hole count back (stableford) from the 18th (second round) will be used to determine the winner.
