Data Protection

Due to the changes to data protection law with the implementation of the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** which came into effect on 25 May 2018, the Club has reviewed its data handling processes. Part of this review entailed data subjects (Club members) having **to make a positive indication** of their willingness to **opt in** and share their data rather than the previous regime whereby data statements asked you to tick the box if you didn't want to be included. Now all data subjects **must positively indicate** that they want to be included. Accordingly, you will notice the two short statements with tick boxes on the renewal form next to the spaces for your contact details.

The first of these asks you to tick a box to allow the club to store and use your data for Club purposes.

As well as using your data to contact you to advise you of club events and other associated matters necessary to allow the club to function, this would also include the release of your contact data (phone numbers and email addresses) to other members on request, to allow any competitions you enter to be successfully managed and ties to be arranged.

The second box and short statement is to allow the club to share your contact data with the Club Professional, Sandy Aird, to enable him to advise you of course availability and to send you his monthly newsletter. This newsletter may contain golfing and equipment promotions directly from Sandy. The contact information we share with Sandy will only be shared with the publisher of his monthly newsletter and **not with any other third parties**.

In order for the club to continue to operate properly to serve its members, and to receive Sandy's newsletter, it is important that you consider the above information carefully and hopefully agree to share your contact data.

McDonald Golf Club Flexible Membership Terms

Definition

Flexible Playing Members are players who have purchased a Flexible Subscription comprising 50 or 100 units at prices determined by the Club Council of McDonald Golf Club.

Flexible Playing Member Privileges and Restrictions

Unit Members are allowed to play in all weekly club medals/stablefords, but not in any other competitions.

They cannot play in the Medal/Stableford finals.

Flexible Playing Members will not be allowed to hold office or speak at General Meetings, nor can they vote at such meetings.

They must hold unused units to remain a Club member.

Unit members have one (1) calendar month to purchase additional units once they have used up all their existing units. Failure to purchase additional units under such circumstances will result in the termination of your membership.

They can upgrade their membership to full Adult Playing Membership at any time by paying the difference between your unit purchase fee (100 or 50 units) and the full Adult Playing Members fee.

Handicap Certificate

Flexible Playing Members are eligible to receive a Handicap Certificate detailing their CONGU recognised handicap approved by the Match and Handicap Convener.

Unit Allocation

The number of units required to play a round of golf shall be determined by the Club Council and may be subject to change at any time, except that unused units already purchased may be redeemed at the rate applicable at the time of purchase. The current unit cost per round at 1st March 2019 shall be;

During the summer playing season (April – September)

5 units for weekdays and 7 units for weekends

During the winter playing season (October – March)

2 units for weekday rounds and 3 units for weekend rounds.

A Flexible Playing Member intending to play less than a full round or terminating their round having played less than 18 holes is still required to record a round for 2, 3, 5 or 7 units as appropriate for the day of the week and playing season.

Unused units may be carried forward from one year into the next but will expire two years after the date of purchase. Unused units will not be refunded.

Administration

The flexible member's points will be recorded in their Fixture Diary, which they must bring to the Club each time they play.

Flexible members **must** book a tee time when playing a round of golf at McDonald Golf Club, they **must** check into the Pro-Shop or Bar/Office if Pro-Shop is closed, before starting their game, where the staff will record their round and mark off their points.

If a player sets off before the Pro Shop or bar is open and the office is not staffed, then they must on completion of their round, report their round to the Pro Shop staff.

Failure to comply with this procedure may result in expulsion from membership of the club and/or the forfeiture of some or all of the outstanding units held by that member.
