

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULE

1ST April till further notice

PREFERRED LIES

Congru Clause 15.3 Preferred lies are in operation.

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area.

Having lifted the ball, he must place it on a spot within 6 inches of and must not be nearer the hole than where it originally lay, and must be in the general area.

This does not mean the rough or semi-rough.

EMBEDDED BALL

Rule 16.3a. Ball must be embedded in general area.

Relief is allowed under Rule 16.3b only when a player's ball is embedded in the general area.

A ball that is **EMBEDDED** in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and **DROPPED** as near as possible to where it lay, within one club-length, but not nearer the hole.
